Springbrook Pool Party Guidelines

The host family must be a registered Springbrook family.

Maximum party length is 3 hours from start to finish which <u>includes time for set up and cleanup</u>.

We allow a maximum of 50 party goers at one time. For example, if you have a party of 30 and there is already a party of 25 scheduled at the same time or overlapping time you would need to find an alternative date or time.

Invitees include all party goers, whether adult or child, member or non-member, swimmer or non-swimmer.

Each party goer 5 years or younger must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult.

The designated party area must be completely clean after the party. Tables wiped clean, all trash and recycling put in appropriate receptacles and decorations taken down. The host family will be fined \$150 if the area is not left clean.

No glass containers are permitted on the pool deck.

Host is responsible for opening the gate for guests.

It is strongly suggested that you tip your party lifeguard. He/she is there to assist you and keep your guests safe.

We reserve one table for every 10 guests.

We do not allow inflatables.

Main pool/tube slide/diving board

Non-swimmers and weak swimmers are not allowed to go down the slide or off the diving board.

One person on the slide at a time.

No swimming in the roped off slide area.

One person on the diving board at a time.

Play pool

Restricted to 6 years and under.

Parent or responsible adult must supervise children at all times.
